



Championships



RULES

Race:

All posted races are open to every one with a valid USA Cycling license. One day and one year licenses available on site. Racers do not have to be exclusively from New England to compete for races General Classification and NEBRA Trophy Series presented by BikeReg.

State/Regional Championships:

These are the official USA Cycling Criterium Championships for New England. Racers competing for championships will need to have a valid ONE YEAR USA Cycling license and reside in the state as shown on their license. One day licenses WILL NOT qualify you to compete for the championships.

Juniors:

Maximum gear 52x14 (7.93m/26'). Blocked gear allowed. Roll out required immediately after crossing the line under judge supervision. Racers not reporting to roll out will be relegated. Pre race roll out suggested to make sure you will pass (self test, ask race official if you have any doubt). Juniors may only receive junior medals if they enter junior races.

Course:

This will be a 1.2 miles closed course around white park.

Protest period:

Results protest will have to be addressed by racers within 15 minutes after results are posted (by awards podium). All other protest will need to be addressed by racers within 15 minutes after they cross the finish line. RACERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING THE USA CYCLING RULES.

Awards:

Overall race cash/merchandise as posted. Results posting after each race is over. Awards ceremony to be conducted 15 minutes after results posting, unless protest in progress. Championships medals as posted.

Sprint competition:

Not a championship event.

Awards ceremony presentation order:

1. Over all race podium (top 3). Others to pick up prizes at registration table.
2. New England regional champions (top 3).
